PERUVIAN WEAVING (1980)

Watch a documentary examining the ancient Andean Indian tradition of warp pattern weaving handed down from woman to woman for some five thousand years. Featuring a detailed demonstration of the technique on backstrap and four-stake looms by Indian weavers, and an interview with Dr. Junius Bird of the American Museum of Natural History, the film explores this significant tradition in the Inca culture. *This film is not rated.
